

Introduction

The journey of inclusive education begins with the Salamanca Statement (1994). UNESCO Salamanca Statement and Framework for Action (1994) proclaimed that:

- "Every child has unique characteristics, interest, abilities and learning needs,"
- "Education system should be designed and educational programmes implemented to take into account the wide diversity of these characteristics and needs,"
- "Those with special educational needs must have access to regular schools which should accommodate them within a child-centered pedagogy capable of meetings these needs,"
