Objectives of the MOU

1. To promote cost-effective eco-friendly products.
2. To raise awareness about waste management i.e. upcycling and recycling.
3. To provide a platform where students can get skill training in digital marketing, recycling in bio-degradable waste materials, production of eco-friendly chemicals for cleaning, bio-fertilizers, bio-pesticides etc via internships.
4. To provide guidance and motivation for entrepreneurship.
5. To provide basic training and motivation for community outreach among women in nearby locality.

Plan of Work

1. Students will get the opportunity to work as interns at Amuktika Industries and learn to make eco-friendly chemicals for cleaning, bio-fertilizers, bio-pesticides etc.
2. Students will learn to upcycle and recycle waste materials from skilled trainers of Amuktika. The flex materials, the blank carton boxes that usually lay unused as garbage can be upcycled to make various useful products like grow bags, files and folders, among other things. In this way they will grow a certain value system regarding management of waste materials. Further students can progress in this activity and start their own creative business initiative.
3. The huge amount of bio-degradable waste materials that is generated from both the students' hostels can be converted into manure and be used for all the plantation activity going on in the campus. The members of Amuktika will be training the students about this waste recycling.
4. Students can contribute in women empowerment by building women self-help groups in their vicinity by guiding female members of the community on various activities they learn from Amuktika. This will be a very important community outreach programme for the students. The leadership skill in them will be honed a great deal.
5. They will receive training in digital marketing, which will increase their employability greatly in the current scenario of job market, where online engagement of the urban as well as rural population is currently at its peak.



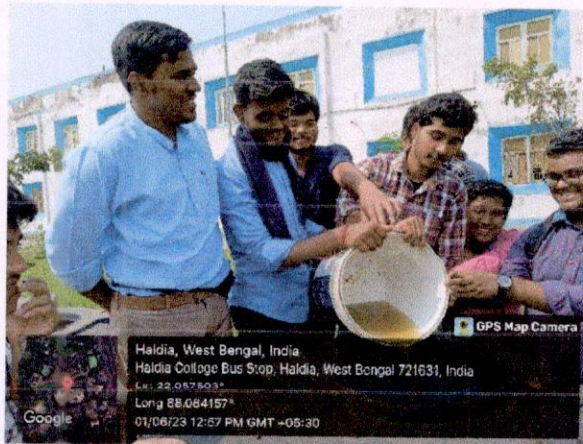

1. Workshop by Amuktika on bio composting and waste management:

On 01/06/2023, a workshop regarding benefits and procedures of bio-composting was organized for students, teachers, and non-teaching staff. Also, hands-on training was given to all regarding bio-composting. Since cultivation of various vegetables and flowers is strongly encouraged in our college campus and various plants are grown in our campus, it is very important to reduce dependency on chemical fertilizers, as it is not only harmful for soil quality but also affects quality of cultivation negatively. The huge amount of bio-degradable waste materials that is generated from both the students' hostels can be converted into manure and be used for all the plantation activity going on in the campus.

2. Students also learnt to upcycle and recycle waste materials from skilled trainers of Amuktika. The flex materials, the blank carton boxes that usually lay unused as garbage can be upcycled to make various useful products like grow bags, files and folders, among other things.
