To address the growing aspiration for education in the minority communities of the state and with a view to providing them more avenues for socio-economic and educational mobility by extending financial support and encouragement to the meritorious students belonging to the minority communities, the State Government has decided to set up the "Aikyashree" – West Bengal State Scholarships for Minority Students in West Bengal to be fully funded from the State budget from the financial year 2019-20 onwards.

2. TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Three types of scholarships will be provided under this scheme:

- (i) Pre-matric Scholarship (for meritorious students from Class-I to Class-X),
- (ii) Post-matric Scholarship (for meritorious students from Class-XI to Ph.D), and
- (iii) Merit-cum-Means Scholarships (for pursuing technical & professional courses).

3. OBJECTIVES:

The primary objective of the Pre-matric Scholarship is to encourage the minority communities to send their children to schools and to prevent drop-out.

The Post-matric scholarship intends to encourage students to continue their pursuit of higher education.

The objective of Merit-cum-Means scholarship for professional and technical courses is to support the students to pursue professional / technical studies for consequently increasing their employability potential.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

A. For Pre-matric Scholarship, and

B. Post-matric Scholarship

- (i) Applicant must be a domicile of West Bengal.
- (ii) Must be studying in a School/Institution recognized by an educational Board/ Council/University of the State/ Central Government.
- (iii) Must have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination.
- (iv) The annual family income should not exceed Rs.2 lakh.
- (v) Students studying in institutes outside West Bengal will not be eligible for pre-matric or post-matric scholarship.

C. For Merit-cum-Means Scholarship

- (i) The applicant must be a domicile of West Bengal.
- (ii) Must have got admission in a technical / professional course.
- (iii) Must have secured at least 50% marks in the last Higher Secondary/ Graduation examination.
- (iv) Annual family income of the student should not be more than Rs.2.5 lakh.
- (v) The students who are residents of West Bengal but pursuing studies in listed institutions located outside West Bengal, as may be notified from time to time by the West Bengal Minorities' Development and Finance Corporation, are also eligible for applying.

5. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Scholarships will be provided to eligible students in order of merit and subject to the budgetary allocation provided by the State Government.

For renewal, the applicant will be eligible for the scholarship if he/she has obtained 50% marks in his/her previous examination.

6. RATES OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

The proposed rates of scholarships are as follows:

7. SANCTION PROCEDURE: .

The applications will be received online through a portal designed for this purpose. The applications will be verified by the Nodal Teachers of the respective School.

The selection will be made as per the eligibility criteria and the disbursement will be made through Direct Bank Transfer.

8. NODAL ORGANISATION:

The West Bengal Minorities' Development & Finance Corporation (WBMDFC) will be the Nodal Organisation for this scheme.

9. CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP:

- (i) The applicant has to submit a certificate regarding family income at the time of application.
- (ii) For 'renewal' applicants, the continuance of scholarship will be subject to securing 50% marks in the previous year examination.
- (iii) Maintenance allowance will be provided to hostellers and day scholars.
- (iv) Students should be regular in attendance, for which the yardstick will be decided by the competent authority of the school.
- (v) If a student violates school discipline or any other terms and conditions of the scholarship, scholarship may be suspended or cancelled. The State Government can also directly cancel the award if duly satisfied of the reasons of violation of these regulations governing the scheme.
- (vi) If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement, his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered.
- (vii) The course/tuition fees and maintenance allowance will be credited to the student's bank account directly under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode.
- (viii) An amount not higher than 2% may be kept for administrative expenses by the WBMDFC for implementation of the Scheme.

NOTIFICATION

The Governor is pleased hereby to announce the Kanyashree Prakalpa 2013, a conditional cash transfer scheme under the Department of Women Development and Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal with the aim of improving the status and well being of the girl child in West Bengal by incentivizing schooling of all teenage girls and delaying their marriages until the age of 18, the legal age of marriage.

Scheme

Short Title and 1. (1). The scheme may be called Kanyashree Prakalpa 2013

Commencement (2). This may come into force from 1st October 2013.

Definitions

- 2. In this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - (1). õEnrolled in an Institution of Education or Trainingö means
 - a. Enrolled in Classes VIII to XII in a school which is recognized by the government
 - b. Enrolled in Secondary and / or Higher Secondary Courses in an open school which is affiliated / accredited / recognized by the government

- c. Enrolled in Classes VIII to XII in a õMadrassahö which is affiliated / accredited / recognized by the government
- d. Enrolled in a course in a Vocational Training Center or a Technical Training Institute which is affiliated / accredited / recognized by government
- e. Enrolled at a Sports training Institute which is affiliated / accredited / recognized by the government.
- (2). õEnrolled in an Institution of Higher Educationö means enrolled in any form of education or learning after Class XII.
- (3). õ**J. J. Home**ö means any home that is registered under the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2000.

Benefits

- 3. There shall be two types of Benefits:
 - (1). Annual scholarship of Rs. 500/-
 - (2). One-Time Grant of Rs. 25,000/-

Eligibility Criteria for Scholarship

- 4. The eligibility criteria for receiving scholarship will be the following:
 - (1). Age of the applicant should be between 13 and 18 years
 - (2). The applicant is not married
 - (3). The applicant is enrolled between class VIII and XII and regularly attending an institution of education or vocational training.
 - (4). The annual family income of the applicant is less than Rupees 1,20,000/- but is waived if the applicant has lost both parents or is physically handicapped.

Eligibility Criteria for Onetime Grant

- 5. The eligibility criteria for receiving the One-time grant will be the following:
 - (1). The applicant must have completed 18 years on or after 1st April -2013 but not completed 19 years during the time of application.
 - (2). The applicant is pursuing education, vocational training or sports activity or is an inmate of any home registered under J.J.Act.
 - (3). The applicant is not married.
 - (4). The annual family income of the applicant is less than Rupees 1,20,000/- but is waived if the applicant has lost both parents or is physically handicapped or is an inmate of home registered under J.J. Act.

Documents Required

- 6. Any undertakings or declarations given by the applicant parent / guardian can be on ordinary paper countersigned by the appropriate certifying authority. The following documents are required to avail the benefits of the scheme:
 - (1) Copy of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal or Panchayat authorities and attested by the appropriate certifying authorities or

- certificate of age issued by the Head of Institution of education or training or institution of higher education or Home registered under J.J. Act where the girl is enrolled.
- Declaration by applicantos parents or guardians in case of scholarship (2) and by applicant in case of one-time grant to the effect that she remains unmarried at the date of application, attested by appropriate certifying authority.
- (3) Declaration of family income by applicant parents or guardians attested by appropriate authority. This declaration not required in case the applicant has lost both parents or is physically handicapped or is an inmate of Home registered under J.J. Act.
- (4) Certificate issued by the Head of Institution of education or training or Institution of higher education or sports organization or Superintendent of Home registered under J.J. Act, declaring her enrolment in the institution.
- Declaration by guardian in case applicant has lost both parents, (5) attested by appropriate certifying authority.
- Copy of Handicapped certificate, if applicable (6)

7. Undertakings or declarations made by the applicant or applicant parents/guardians may be certified by any of the following:

- Group A Officer of State Government or of the Government of India (1).who is either posted in the area, or is a resident of the area.
- **(2)**. Member of Parliament, Member of Legislature of the area of residence of the applicant.
- Councillor of ward of Municipal areas, Gram Panchayat Pradhan of (3). the area of residence of the applicant.

Payment Mode 8. The Scholarship or One-Time grant will be paid to the beneficiaries by way of fund transfer through a bank account only. For minor girl joint bank account

will be preferably under the guardianship of mother/female guardian.

- (1). Having a bank account in the applicantos name is not a pre-requisite at the time of applying for either of the Schemeøs benefits. Once an application is approved, the applicant will be helped in opening and operating a bank account by the banking partner).
- (2). The implementation will be through lead bank system at state, district and block level.
- 9. State, district, Kolkata Municipal Corporation and block level Steering and Monitoring Committees shall be established to steward the Scheme in their respective areas. For the District of Darjeeling, there will be two District Steering and Monitoring Committees, one for Gorkhaland Territorial Authority and the other for non-GTA areas

Appropriate Certifying Authority

Management Structures

- (1). The Scheme will be implemented by Project Management Units, with one unit at the State level, and one in each district in West Bengal. The District-level Project Management teams will function under the supervision of the State Project Management Unit.
- (2). The SPMU will be established within West Bengal Women Development Undertaking under the Department of Women Development and Social Welfare, and be composed of a State Project Manager (Kanyashree), a Deputy Project Manager (Kanyashree) and an Accounts Officer, to be appointed either from regular service or senior Consultants on contract. They will be assisted by accountants-cum-data managers who must be proficient in common office applications, especially word processing, spreadsheets, presentation and accounting software, to be appointed on contract.
- (3). In all districts, with the exception of Kolkata, the DPMU shall be established under the office of the District Magistrate. In Kolkata, the DPMU will be established under the office of Commissioner, Social Welfare. For the district of Darjeeling, there will be two District Project Management Units, one for GTA and the other for non GTA areas. The former will be established under the office of Principal Secretary GTA and the latter under the office of District Magistrate, Darjeeling.
- (4). There will be one Project Manager, to be appointed from regular services or on contract and one Accountant, to be appointed on contract for each such Project Management Unit, in addition to at least two accounts cum data managers, on contract.

Appointments

10. All new appointments will be made for 3 years on probation basis from qualified persons or retired Government employees

Madam / Sir,

I am directed to say that the three Scholarship Schemes viz. Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes are being implemented as Central Sector Scheme, with 100% Central funding for the year 2018-19. Under these schemes, the scholarships are awarded to the economically weaker and meritorious students from six notified minority communities viz. Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Zoroastrian (Parsis) and Jain, pursuing studies in India in a Government or Private Universities/Institutes/ colleges/schools.

- 2. The Central Government has decided to open the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) on 23rd July, 2018 for the three Scholarship Schemes for 2018-19. The last date for receipt of online applications will be 30th September, 2018. As such, it is incumbent upon this Ministry to initiate the process of issue of advertisement inviting online applications, by the State Government/UT Administrations, which shall be implemented as per existing guidelines. At the National level, Ministry of Minority Affairs will be issuing advertisement.
- 3. The State-wise/Community-wise physical allocation (as per Census 2011) for Fresh Scholarship in respect of three Scholarship Schemes for the financial year 2018-19 is 30 lakh, 5 lakh and 60,000 for fresh scholarships (Copy enclosed). As far as renewal applications are concerned, there is no target for them and all renewal applications are eligible for scholarship.
- Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes will be done through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) of the Government of India, under URL www.scholarships.gov.in. A link to the site is also made available in the website of this Ministry i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. Only Online applications under the Schemes will be accepted and no request for Offline applications will be entertained. This may be brought out clearly in the Advertisement. The detailed guidelines of the three Scholarship Schemes and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) with the timelines is available on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). A copy of the Standard Operation Procedure (SOP) has already been circulated last year (copy enclosed).

- In view of above, all State Governments/UT Administrations are requested to take the following action:
 - (i) All the schemes need to be announced by the concerned State Government/UT Administration well in time, through advertisements in the leading language newspapers and local dailies and by using other suitable publicity media well in time.
 - (ii) The tentative timeline activities for receiving online applications and closing of portal for the year 2018-19 for fresh and renewal of scholarships in respect of Pre-matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means to the given to States/UTs at present are as under:-

- (iii) The advertisement will enable the minority students to avail the maximum benefits of scholarship schemes.
- (iv) All Universities/Institutes/colleges/schools located in your State/UT may be advised to register themselves and their courses details on the NSP by 15th August, 2018 so that their students can apply and they can verify such applications on the portal without any delay.
- (v) In the Advertisement, the State / UT Department may also invite attention of the students to the guidelines of the three Scholarship Schemes and the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) available on the NSP homepage of the website for filling up of Online Application.

- (vi) All renewal applicants/students (applicants who have got scholarship during 2017-18) may apply by giving their existing Application ID.
 - (vii) All the three Scholarship schemes are an individual beneficiary oriented scheme being implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and the whole scholarship is disbursed to the beneficiary under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode. In this regard, it is stated that the linkage of beneficiary's identification with UID/Aadhaar number is presently non-mandatory. However, as the Gazette Notification under Section-7 of Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (with respect to this scheme) has been notified (a copy of Gazette Notification S.O.1284(E) (No.1137) dated 21.04.2017 is enclosed for reference), it will be necessary for the eligible applicants to provide Aadhaar number while applying for the scholarship and in case, an individual does not possess Aadhaar one can provide the details of alternative identification documents, as stated in the Gazette Notification, detailed below:
 - (a) if she or he has enrolled, her or his Aadhaar Enrolment ID slip; or a copy of her or his request made for Aadhaar enrolment, as specified in subparagraph (b) of paragraph 2; and
 - (b) Bank passbook with photograph; or (ii) Ration Card, or (iii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card issued by the Income Tax Department; or (iv) Passport; or (v) Certificate of identity having photo of such student issued by a Headmaster or Principal of School under official seal of the school; or (vi) Driving license issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or (vii) any other documents specified by the State Government or Union territory Administration. [Note: for Assam, Jammu & Kashmir and Meghalaya, the documents mentioned in para (b) shall only be required].
- (vii) All efforts may be made to adhere to the timelines given on the portal and resolve any technical issue that may crop up in the process of online submission, generation of merit lists and payment lots by coordinating with the State NICs.
