A JUDGING PANEL COMPRISING EXPERIENCED FILMMAKERS, INDUSTRY PROFESSIONALS, AND FACULTY MEMBERS METICULOUSLY REVIEWED EACH SUBMISSION TO IDENTIFY THE MOST COMPELLING AND INNOVATIVE SHORT FILMS.





THIS COMPREHENSIVE ANALYSIS REFLECTS THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO APPEARED AND PASSED THE FINAL YEAR EXAMINATIONS FROM 2019 TO 2023. IN 2019, OUT OF 50 STUDENTS, 48 SUCCESSFULLY PASSED THEIR EXAMINATIONS. 
